

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT HANDOUT

EAST STATE ROAD PROJECT IN CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP, VENANGO CO.


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project is for the resurfacing of East State Road (Route 2006) from Route 257 to Hill City Road (Route 2015) in Venango County. Additional work will include the replacement of a deteriorated pipe culvert between the intersection of Horsecreek Road and Hill City Road.

The existing metal pipe at this location is rusted through the bottom which is causing undermining of the backfill material around the culvert. The pipe is experiencing excessive section loss and deformation due to corrosion. As a result, the edge of the existing roadway is beginning to fail. It will be replaced with a concrete pipe and the roadway in that area will be reconstructed.

Work will be part of a contract that also includes paving on Deep Hollow Road (Route 3025) from Route 322 to Bredinsburg Road (Route 2006) and Rockland Cranberry Road (Route 2013) from East Sandy Creek Bridge to Route 322.

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
ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION

This project will be completed during the 2023 construction season. Work is set to begin in June 2023 and the full project will take approximately three months to complete.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Traffic will be detoured only during the replacement of the pipe culvert. The 8.6 mile detour will be posted using Hill City Road, Mapleshade Road (Route 2004), Route 322, and Route 257. The detour is expected to be in place for approximately two days during the replacement of the pipe culvert.

Other portions of the work may require the use of lane restrictions and flaggers.



CONSTRUCTION FUNDING

The estimated cost for this portion of the project is \$1.2 million and will be funded entirely with state funds.

CURRENT PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The purpose of the public comment period is to introduce the project and receive input regarding any questions or concerns with the project. It is also an opportunity for the public to review and comment on the project's potential effect upon Cultural Resources pursuant to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's 36 CFR Part 800 regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The project documents can be made available in alternative languages or formats if requested.
