PURPOSE OF PRESENTATION & PROJECT INFORMATION


- The purpose of this presentation is to introduce the project to the public and present the proposed design.
- The scope of the project is to mill and resurface Babcock Boulevard to remove surface defects and imperfections for ride improvement and safety. The project extends from the intersection of Babcock Boulevard and Cumberland Road to the Allegheny and Butler County line. The scope also includes replacement of two drainage pipes (in North Park near the Babcock Boulevard and Lake Marshall intersection) and the seal replacement, guiderail replacement, and joint and deck sealing of a structure crossing the PA Turnpike. Additional work will include base repairs, drainage repairs, signage and guiderail updates / upgrades and pavement markings as needed within the project limits.







PROJECT LOCATION








PROPOSED PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Mill and Resurface majority of Babcock Boulevard with base repair as needed
 - Reconstruct Babcock Boulevard and the shoulder in detour area
- Update guide rail and pavement markings on Babcock Boulevard
- Minor drainage and structure work on Babcock Boulevard
- No acquisition of Right-of-Way required All work will be performed within Department ROW or slope easement
- Construction anticipated to begin summer of 2024
 - Short term lane restrictions on Babcock Boulevard for majority of project
 - Road will be closed (in North Park near the Babcock Boulevard and Lake Marshall intersection) and detoured for full reconstruction
 - Road closure is anticipated to be approximately 3 days
 - Proposed detour is approximately 9.2 miles





PROPOSED DETOUR



Majority of the project will have short-term lane restrictions.

During pipe replacement and reconstruction of roadway and shoulder in North Park near intersection of Babcock Blvd and Lake Marshall Drive, the roadway will be closed for a weekend and follow detour:

> Northbound on SR 4031 (Babcock Blvd) West on SR 4070 (Ingomar Road) North on Route 19 East on SR 910 (Wexford Road)

Southbound on SR 4031 (Babcock Blvd) West on SR 910 (Wexford Road) South on Route 19 East on SR 4070 (Ingomar Road)

Start - Summer 2024

End - Fall 2024

Detour – August 2024*

*This closure may change based on contractor's discretion.

Approximate Project Cost: \$6,500,000
