PennDOT Cameron/Potter County Maintenance Work Schedule for the Week of September 26 – September 30, 2022

Emporium/Coudersport, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Cameron/Potter County Maintenance announces the following work schedule for the week of September 26 – September 30, weather permitting. Motorists should travel with extra caution in these and all work areas. Motorists should be aware that due to the nature of highway maintenance and emergency work, crews could be working on any highway at any time of the day or night.

Cameron County 0240

Brushing:

- State Route: Various SR throughout County

Joint Repair:

- State Route: 0120 (Elk County Line to Emporium)

Painting Railroad Crossing Markings:

- State Route: 0555 (Low Grade Road)

Potter County 0260

Bridge Repair/Replacement:

- State Route: State Route 0244 (Oswayo to Coneville)

Sign Repairs/Replacement:

- State Route: Various SR throughout County

Shoulder Repair:

- State Route: 0044 (Cherry Springs to Carter Camp)

Pipe Replacement:

- State Route: 0244 (Oswayo to Andrews Settlement)

Spray Patching:

- State Route: 1019 (Whites Corners Road)
- State Route: 1016 (North Fork Road)

Ditching:

- State Route: 0049 (Gold Area)
- State Route: 0449 (Gold Area to Genesee)

The following work is scheduled to be completed by contractor, weather permitting:

Cameron County 0240

- Francis J. Palo, Inc: Bridge Repair on State Route 4004 (Rich Valley Road) in Shippen Township.

Potter County 0260

- Glenn O. Hawbaker Inc: Paving on State Route 4003 (Fishing Creek Road) and continue to 4005 (Whitney Creek Road).
