PennDOT Clinton County Maintenance work schedule for the week of October 24 – October 28, 2022

Mill Hall, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Clinton County Maintenance announces the following work schedule for the week of October 24 – October 28, weather permitting. Motorists should travel with extra caution in these and all work areas. Motorists should be aware that due to the nature of highway maintenance and emergency work, crews could be working on any highway at any time of the day or night.

Clinton County 0230

Guiderail:

- Various State Routes throughout the County on the next three (3) Saturdays 10/22, 10/29 and 11/5.

The following work is scheduled to be completed by contractor, weather permitting:

Nestlerode Contracting Company – Bridge Replacement - State Route: 64 – Contractor will be working on milling of roadway, grading of roadway and paving of base and binder, all in the closed portion of the bridge. Temporary traffic barrier will be removed. Placement of the wearing course will take place the week of 10/31/2022. **Temporary traffic signal will remain until 11/14/2022. Motorists are reminded to remain alert and cautious in this and all work zones.**

Swank Construction - SR120 (Renovo Bridge) – Contractor will be working on substructure and superstructure repairs. Traffic will continue in one lane with temporary traffic signals. **Motorists are reminded to remain alert and cautious in this and all work zones.**

Clearwater Construction, Inc – SR1001 (Farrandsville Road) – Relocating electric utility lines and patching water and sewer line trenches. **Motorists will encounter daily lane closures regulated by flaggers.**

Glenn O. Hawbaker, Inc.: - **SR 150 (The Monument to the Constitution Bridge)** – Paving is complete. Shoulder backup is taking place 10/21. Guiderail replacement is scheduled for Monday, 10/24. **Motorists are reminded to be alert and cautious in the work zone.**

Motorists are encouraged to “Know Before They Go” by checking conditions on more than 40,000 roadway miles by visiting www.511PA.com. 511PA, which is free and available 24 hours a day, provides traffic delay warnings, weather forecasts, traffic speed information and access to more than 1,000 traffic cameras.
