PennDOT McKean County Maintenance work schedule for the week of September 26 – September 30, 2022

Cyclone, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation McKean County Maintenance announces the following work schedule for the week of September 26 – September 30, weather permitting. Motorists should travel with extra caution in these and all work areas. Motorists should be aware that due to the nature of highway maintenance and emergency work, crews could be working on any highway at any time of the day or night.

McKean County 0250

Sign Repairs and Upgrades:

- Various State Routes throughout the County

Bridge Repair:

- State Route: Various Repairs throughout county

Patching:

- State Route: 0446 (Main Street, Eldred)
- State Route: 1011 (Barnum Road)
- State Route: 1006 (McCrae Brook Road)
- State Route: 0546 (Oil Valley Road)

Shoulder Cutting:

- State Route: 0146 (Red Mill Road)
- State Route: 0059 (Ormsby/Marshburg Road)

Pipe Replacement:

- State Route: 0246 (Looker Mountain Trail)

Pipe Trench Patching:

- State Route: 1009 (Bell Run Road)

The following work is scheduled to be completed by contractor, weather permitting:

- Glenn O. Hawbaker, Inc: Resurfacing State Route 0046, Project will consist of replacing a box culvert, drainage improvements, guide rail installation, pavement marking and other miscellaneous construction,
- Glenn O. Hawbaker, Inc: Resurfacing, and bridge repair State Route 0219 (Bradford Area), Drivers will take the off-ramp at the Owens Way interchange, stop at the end of the ramp, and proceed back onto SR 0219 northbound via the on-ramp.

- Glenn O. Hawbaker, Inc: Resurfacing Bridge decks and approaches on State Route 2001.
