THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IS IN THE FINAL ENGINEERING PHASE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE BRIDGE LOCATED ALONG STATE ROUTE 1001 IN WEST WHITELAND TOWNSHIP. THE ROADWAY ALIGNMENT FOR STATE ROUTE 1001 WILL BE SHIFTED TO THE WEST. SHIP ROAD WILL BE CLOSED DURING CONSTRUCTION WITH A VEHICULAR DETOUR ROUTE IN PLACE TO MAINTAIN TRAFFIC.

THE DETOUR WILL USE STATE ROUTE 3070 (EAST LINCOLN HWY) AND PA ROUTE 100 (NORTH POTTSTOWN PIKE). THE START OF CONSTRUCTION IS ANTICIPATED TO BEGIN IN SUMMER OF 2025 AND WILL TAKE APPROXIMATELY 7 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.
