Route 611 (Old York Road) Bridge Replacement Project SR 0611, Section MBR Abington Township & Jenkintown Borough, Montgomery County MPMS# 16214

Project Purpose

The purpose of this project is to replace the existing deteriorating bridge carrying SR 0611 (Old York Road) over the SEPTA railroad at Noble Station in Abington Township and Jenkintown Borough, Montgomery County.

Project Needs

The following needs have been identified for the project:

- The existing multi-beam, three-span bridge, that was built in 1905 is rated in poor condition.
- There is no pedestrian access to Noble Station from the western side of Old York Road, and the existing stairs do not meet current ADA guidelines.
- ADA ramps missing; existing ADA ramps at the intersections of Rodman Avenue and Baeder Road are not all in compliance with PennDOT Standards.
- Outdated pedestrian signals, insufficient or failing pedestrian actuation, inadequate pedestrian access that creates unsafe conditions for pedestrians.
- Signalized intersections have faded pavement markings. Safety during wet weather due to lack of sufficient drainage facilities.
