PROJECT LIMITS



PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Road widening to add left turn lanes on Church Road at Greenwood Avenue
 - New traffic signals
 - New pedestrian ADA ramps and crosswalks
- Road widening to add northbound Greenwood Avenue right turn lane
- New curbing along Church Road and Greenwood Avenue
- New sidewalk on the north side of Church Road from Greenwood Avenue to Rices Mill Road
- New sidewalk on the south side of Church Road from Randall Road to Greenwood Avenue



PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Intersection improvements at Church Road and Rices Mill Road:
 - New traffic signals
 - Advance left turn phase for eastbound Church Road
 - New pedestrian ADA ramps and crosswalks

DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS


- Curb and roadway drainage will be installed along Church Road and Greenwood Avenue to capture and convey roadway runoff.
- An estimated 46 inlets and 4,300 feet of drainage pipe will be installed.
- The project will meet peak rate, volume, and water quality requirements for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.
- Peak flow rates are reduced to less than the existing peak flows in all storm events, up to and including the 100-year, 24-hour storm.
- Proposed stormwater management basin to be installed along Greenwood Avenue.

CURTIS ARBORETUM

- Approximately 22, 1-foot caliper trees will be planted along the Arboretum's Church Road and Greenwood Avenue frontage (21 trees will be removed)
- The Arboretum perimeter stone wall along Church Road and Greenwood Avenue will be rebuilt and faced with stone to resemble the original wall

UTILITY CONSTRUCTION


- Advance utility relocations
 - Requires off-peak lane closures and detours
 - Aqua will replace the existing water main from Panther Road to Heacock Lane
 - Enbridge will relocate a pipeline between Randall Road and Greenwood Avenue




PENNDOT CONSTRUCTION

- One-way detours on Church Road and Greenwood Avenue will be needed to construct the drainage and pavement improvements
- Phases of construction:
 - Phase 1 construction work outside of the existing roadways (all roadways open)
 - Phase 2 Detour Route 73/Church Road west and Greenwood Avenue south
 - Phase 3 Detour Route 73/Church Road east and Greenwood Avenue north
 - Phase 4 construction work using short term traffic patterns (all roadways open)





