


## U.S. 422 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

### U.S. 422 Projects in Design:

#### U.S. 422 Schuylkill River Bridge to Hanover Road (U.S. 422, Section M2B)

- Estimated Cost: \$130 million
- Estimated Let Date: Winter 2025

This project will reconstruct 1.5 miles of U.S. 422 including the replacement of three bridges carrying U.S. 422 over Laurelwood Road, Route 100, and Hanover Street; reconstruct the ramps at the Route 100 and Hanover Street interchanges; and improve the outer acceleration and deceleration lanes at the Route 100 and Hanover Street interchanges in North Coventry Township, Chester County.



#### U.S. 422 Keim Street and Route 724 Interchange (U.S. 422 Section M03)

- Estimated Cost: \$92 million
- Estimated Let Date: Summer 2027

This project will reconstruct U.S. 422 from 1,500 feet west of Keim Street to the Schuylkill River Bridge including two bridges, concrete glare screen, and acceleration and deceleration lanes at the Keim Street and Route 724 interchanges in North Coventry Township, Chester County.
