

PennDOT District 6 Middle School Safety Drawing Contest - 2020

Calling all Philadelphia Region Middle School Students!!

Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) is asking our Philadelphia Region middle school students for help in saving lives and keeping bicyclists, motorists, and pedestrians safe through our Middle School Safety Drawing Contest campaign, which will run through, Friday, June 12.

This year the theme is Bike Safety. The drawing contest is a community outreach program in which students are invited to create a drawing that promotes bike safety and is open to all middle school students, grades 5th to 8th, in Philadelphia, Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Montgomery counties.

The drawing is to be done on 8.5 X 11 paper and can either be scanned in and emailed or a photo of drawing can also be emailed in to robbriggs@pa.gov. Students' artwork must be original and in good taste; anything deemed inappropriate will be precluded. Only non-partisan, non-political, and non-violent material will be accepted. All submissions must also not infringe on the right of third parties, including but not limited to intellectual property rights, for copy writing purposes.

All drawings will be entered to win the 2020 PennDOT District 6 Middle School Safety Drawing Contest and the student will be deemed PennDOT's District 6 Middle School Safety Ambassador for 2020. The winning drawing will be featured on PennDOT's social media accounts.
