

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project includes approximately 3 miles of roadway widening, overlay, and safety improvements on SR 2005 (Camp Betty Washington Road and Haines Road) from the SR 2002 (Springwood Road) intersection to approximately the SR 0124 (Mount Rose Avenue) intersection.

Additional improvements along SR 2005 include:

- Replacement of the bridges over Mill Creek and an Unnamed Tributary of Mill Creek
- The addition of an unsignalized northbound left turn lane at Chestnut Hill Road
- Drainage, guide rail, signing, and pavement marking upgrades
- Removal of rock outcrops, stone walls, vegetation, or other hazardous features along the corridor

PROJECT PURPOSE

To provide a safer roadway corridor for the traveling public and replace two structures that are considered structurally obsolete.

PROJECT NEED

- Narrow roadway, with little to no shoulders, causing vertical drop-offs
- Limited sight distance due to vegetation and other obstructions
- Icy conditions due to vegetation shading the roadway
- Substandard bridges
- Higher crash rates than state wide average
